([Isa 53](#) 🗣️)

Many prefer to think of Jesus as a meek, mild, gentle, loving Shepherd. His names we love: Prince of Peace, The Good Shepherd, Morning Star but what of Isaiah's name (vs 3) "Man of Sorrows (vs 3,5,7,10,11).

Jesus endured the very depth of human pain and suffering, so as to identify with everything we face.

Four Pains of the Man of Sorrows:

(1) Relational pain

([Matt 26:30](#) 🗣️)

Closest friends failed Him

([Matt 26:36-38](#) 🗣️)

Gethsemane means "oil press"

Which associate/identifies with pain and anguish (Mat 26:40-46)

(2) Internal pain

The Lord Jesus knew that one day He would drink the cup His Father would give to Him, but knowing it did not remove the internal agony when the Zero hour arrived.

Note: Sweat became as great drops of blood

(3) Physical pain

([Isa 50:6](#) & [Isa 52:14](#) ) and four gospels gives us a picture of great agony, pain but there was something worse

(4) Ultimate pain – separation from God

([Matt 27:45](#) ,46)

As He was made sin, the absolute pain and loneliness, Jesus cried out to His Father.

You cannot have a heartache that Jesus does not understand.

Without one word from your lips He understands.
