Sometimes after an update is done to the site, the page might not look like any changes were made or certain links will be sending you to the wrong page. This is because the internet browsers such as Firefox, IE, Chrome, Safari, and others will "take pictures" of the site as you visit it in

**Q: How do you do clear your cache?**

**A:** The process of clearing cache differs from browser to browser. Generally speaking, look for an option to delete cache or temporary files in your browser's administrative settings. For more specific instructions, simply type in "how do I clear browser cache for [internet explorer]" into a search engine and it should pull up any information that you need.
