

The Seven Redemptive Names Of God - Part 1

Part 1 *THE SEVEN REDEMPTIVE NAMES OF GOD*

([Exod 6:2](#) 🗣️,3 & [Psl 83:18](#))

Jehovah means “The Lord” not only is He All-Powerful, All-Knowing, He is All Self-Existent, who reveals Himself to man.

*In the redemption relationship with man, the Lord Jehovah has seven Hebrew names attributed to Him. Each one of those names reveals two truths:

1) He is the Lord who meets every need of mankind

2) Each one of these names point to the Lord Jesus Christ and His redemption for us on Calvary

(1) Jehovah-Shamma: The Lord is there or the Lord is present

([Eze 48:35](#)) “The Lord is there”

*When Israel was delivered from Egypt God gave them a great promise

([Exod 13:21](#) 🗣️,22 Read)

*They knew whatever time of day it was God was there.

([Matt 28:20](#) 🗣️) Jesus said “Lo I am with you always”

*It is thru the blood of Jesus Christ that we have assurance He is ever with us.

([Eph 2:13](#) 🗣️ & [Heb 13:5](#) 🗣️ Read)

(2) Jehovah-Shalom: The Lord our Peace

([Judg 6:23](#) 🗣️,24 Read)

*Because Israel failed to obey God in destroying their enemies when they entered the Promise Land, God allowed those enemies to trouble Israel. One such group was the Midianites. They took Israel’s animals, their harvest, and destroyed what they didn’t take.

*Gideon a meek young man, who along with his parents faced great persecution from them is paid a visit by the Angel of God, thinking he would die, the Lord spoke the above words ([Judg 6:23](#) 🗣️,24) and Gideon built an alter and worshiped God.

*Just as Israel needed peace, man needs peace and the only one who can provide it is Jehovah-Shalom.

*Some in this world are finding out that job security, money in the bank, and good health does not guarantee peace or security.

*So how can peace rule in the turbulent world I live in?

([Rom 5:1](#) 🗣️ Read)

([Col 1](#)) tells us Jesus Christ made peace for us thru the blood of His cross.

(3) Jehovah-Raah: The Lord my Shepherd

(Psl 23:1) "The Lord is my shepherd"

*We see in just these simple words of a personal relationship between David and the Lord.

*There is no doubt in my mind this relationship was forged in the young years of David as he tended his father's flock. His trust and confidence in God is revealed as he faced the giant Goliath and his persecution of Saul as he tried to kill David.

*Can you say the Lord Jesus is your Shepherd?

([John 10:11](#), 15 Read)

*Most preachers agree that Psl 22, Psl 23 and Psl 24 reveal three glorious pictures of Jesus the Shepherd.

(Psl 22) The Good Shepherd: who was crucified and resurrected and is the hope of all lost men for salvation.

(Psl 23) The Great Shepherd: who cares for His sheep that they may declare "The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want".

(Psl 24) The Chief Shepherd: just as King David returned the Ark to Jerusalem, so the Lord of Glory Jesus Christ shall return as the King of Zion.
